THE CRESCENT LAKE WATERSHED GRANT **IS CURRENTLY UNDERWAY!**

The Maine Department of Environmental Protection (Maine DEP) awarded the **Town of Raymond** a grant to protect water quality in the Crescent Lake Watershed. **The project is designed to increase education and awareness about water quality issues, and fix erosion problems on residential properties, youth summer camps, and public & private roads.**

RESIDENTIAL MATCHING GRANTS *are still available for private landowners in the Crescent Lake Watershed!*

These projects are aimed at fixing **erosion problems** located on residential properties around Crescent Lake. Landowners receive **FREE technical assistance**, site plans, and will be reimbursed for up to \$300 worth of materials. A number of landowners have taken advantage of the technical assistance and grant funds available to fix erosion issues on their property, but **WE NEED MORE PROJECTS TO WORK ON!**
