Voted: That the Superintendent of Schools (the "Superintendent") is authorized to accept the proposal of Gorham Leasing Group (the "Bank") to provide tax-exempt lease purchase financing for two 2014 Dodge Caravans (38,221 and 41,371 miles) (the "Equipment") in the principal amount of \$37,204 (\$18,602 each at an interest rate of 2.10% for a term of up to 3 years; and that under and pursuant to the provisions of Title 20-A M.R.S. The Superintendent/designee's decision in each case shall be final.
