LED streetlights installed around Raymond

Starting on Tuesday, December 10th, RL Todd & Sons out of Caribou, Maine started the installation of 110 LED streetlights around Raymond. The project, which started back in 2018 and included the surrounding towns of Windham, Gorham and Standish is nearing completion. Raymond was the first of the four towns to get their lights installed. They are equipped with smart controls allowing for local control in intensity or brightness of the lights and the ability to turn them off or on, if necessary. The Town will also be able to troubleshoot problems faster and will be able to see quickly if any of the lights have failed or are experiencing problems.

The process, which has been facilitated by RealTerm Energy, a consultant company, required the collaboration of the other involved towns as they all moved together through the process. Each town also had to complete acquisition of the old light fixtures from Central Maine Power. The LED lights are more reliable and last up to six times longer with over 100,000 hours of estimated life. They are also better for the environment, as they contain no toxic elements and contribute less light pollution than the traditional sodium bulbs.

RL Todd & Sons will

also serve as the subcontractor for RealTerm Energy in the event that any of the lights needs to be replaced or serviced.




A native Mainer, Melanie started studying art at the Western Maine Arts Group as a child. She stayed with this group, learning the basics of oil and watercolor painting until graduating from
