Second Half Tax Payments are due April 30th





ONE YEAR LATER

The Town of Raymond is now one year into our COVID-19 response. Front and center to our efforts has been our Health Officer, Cathy Gosselin. Cathy has provided countless hours of education, support, and research not only to assist town staff to navigate all the best practices and ins and outs of Coronavirus, but she has also provided support to local businesses, helping them to continue operating in a safe manner. She has worked hard to stay up to date with all the best practices and Maine CDC guidelines, along with coordinating a phone tree to check on vulnerable citizens, run errands for those in quarantine and has been the point person for questions on Covid-19 testing sites, and now is helping to find vaccination sites. Cathy has been with the Raymond Fire & Rescue Department for 22 years, she is also the Deputy Fire Chief!

As we have all been affected by the pandemic, we urge all of you to continue to follow the recommendations on mask wearing, washing hands and social distancing. It is our hope that in the next few months as more get vaccinated, the CDC will lift some of the restrictions.

Instead of presents this year, she wanted to receive money that she could donate to a cause in Raymond. She was told of several entities that she could support, such as the Food Panty or the Library. In the end, Emma decided that she wanted to donate to the Raymond Fire & Rescue Department. Her family held a drive-by birthday with a collection bucket placed outside. She was able to raise \$30!



This is not the first time Emma has done something like this. She once emptied her piggy bank and donated every penny to Daisy's Children a non-profit organization based out of Southern Maine that provides food, water and shelter to children and families in Honduras, her great grandmother, Linda Eldridge explained to me.
