

GENERAL ASSISTANCE **NOTICE**

The Municipality of Raymond administers a General Assistance Program for the support of the poor. Pursuant to Title 22 MRSA §4305, the Municipal Officers have adopted an ordinance establishing that program. A copy of this ordinance is available for public inspection at the Town Office. Also available for inspection is a copy of the State's General Assistance Statutes, as copies of the State Law are made available to the Municipality by the Maine Department of Health & Human Services.

Persons who wish to apply for General Assistance may do so by calling the Raymond Town Office at 207-655-4742 x129 for an appointment. Appointments are done on Tuesdays from 9:00am to 11:00am.

In an after-hours emergency, applicants may contact the Cumberland County Regional Communications Center by phone at 893-2810.

The Municipality's General Assistance administrator must issue a written decision within 24 hours of receiving an application. The Department of Health & Human Services' toll-free telephone number, to call with a question regarding the General Assistance Program, is 1-800-442-6003.
